- 1. Successful applicants will receive notification email from IC within one week after the applicant deadline.
- 2. Applicants who do not receive any notification email within one week after the application deadline may consider their applications unsuccessful.

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# **Available Subsidy Scheme**

Appendix A

# A) Education Bureau's Subsidy Scheme on Exchange to "Belt and Road" Regions (SSBER)

Eligibility: IC full-time undergraduate students

- in receipt of means-tested student financial assistance from Student Finance Office (SFO)
  of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency; OR
- 2. whose families are in receipt of the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA). AND
- 3. with satisfactory academic performance, for example minimum GPA of 2.50, or average mark of 65, or average grade B-;
- 4. who submit a reflective journal within 1 month after the tour.

### Maximum subsidy: HK\$6,500

The subsidy granted for SSEBR is subjected to the destination and duration of the exchange activity and the applicant's level of student finance (in terms of percentage of full grant) approved by SFO. For this tour the maximum subsidy is the sum of below,

|   | Subsidy amount (HK\$) |
|---|-----------------------|
| Destination Subsidy: Asia (including Middle East) | 3,000                 |
| Duration Subsidy: 5 – 13 days                     | 3,500                 |

Actual subsidy to be granted for an individual = SUM of above X his/her LEVEL OF STUDENT FINANCE

# Example of calculation:

- Case 1) A student received  $\underline{100\%}$  of full grant from SFO joins this tour, the maximum amount of the subsidy to be granted is (\$3,000+\$3,500) x  $\underline{100\%}$  =  $\underline{$6,500}$
- Case 2) A student received  $\underline{70\%}$  of full grant from SFO joins this tour, the maximum amount of the subsidy to be granted is  $(\$3,000+\$3,500) \times 70\% = \underline{\$4,550}$

# B) HKU SPACE Foundation Sponsorship

Eligibility: IC full-time undergraduate students

- 1. with satisfactory academic performance;
- 2. who submit a reflective journal within 1 month after the tour.

Amount of subsidy: HK\$3,000 (may varies slightly depending on the no. of applicants)
