## Eligibility

1. This programme is open to all full-time IC undergraduate students.
2. Student must have a **valid Home Visit Permit** for travelling to Mainland during the period. Please remember to check for the expiry date before you apply.

## Programme Fee

1. **HK\$2,900** per each student.
2. This amount will be collected before the study tour.

## Certificate of Attendance

Upon successful completion of the course, students will obtain the **Certificate of Attendance** from **ECNU**.

## Application Process

1. Students who are interested to apply, please submit the **Application Form** with photocopies of your travelling documents to IC.
2. Students will also need to submit a short essay, in less than 100 words (English), describe your reasons and expectations of attending this programme and what makes you a good ambassador for IC.

## Announcement of Result

1. Successful applicants will receive a notification email by IC within one week after the applicant deadline.
2. Applicants who do not receive the offer one week after the application deadline may consider their applications unsuccessful.

## Pre-Trip Workshops

Successful applicants will need to attend 2 x pre-trip workshops where you will meet your teammates, learn important information and be prepared for the trip. Details will be announced by IC later.

## Being An Ambassador

As you are representing IC while you are in Shanghai, so it is important that you are an excellent ambassador. Your successes and struggles directly affect IC's ability to send future students to exchange partners and create overseas exchange or study opportunities.
