# **Application for Absence from Examinations**

### **Application Procedures and Deadlines**

If students are unable to attend an examination under extenuating circumstances such as serious sickness, they should apply for absence from examination by submitting:

- 1) Completed form **Application for Absence from Examination(s)** [HP43-ABE], which is available in the Learner Portal (under My Resource → Student Services Forms),
- 2) Original copy of the relevant supporting document(s); and
- 3) A non-refundable application fee, which is HK\$300 per course

to the College Office (18/F, HPSHCC campus) during \*service hours within <u>five</u> working days after that day of the respective course examination (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and School Holidays) as illustrated below. Late applications will not be considered.

In case of sickness, the College will ONLY accept medical certificates issued by registered doctors (註冊 西醫) or Chinese medicine practitioners (註冊中醫)<sup>1</sup> in Hong Kong. The date(s) of sick leave granted

The list of registered Chinese medicine practitioners can be obtained from the website of Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong <a href="http://www.cmchk.org.hk/">http://www.cmchk.org.hk/</a>). According to the *Reference Guide on Issuance of Sick Leave Certificate by Registered Chinese Medicine Practitioners* (<a href="http://www.cmchk.org.hk/cmp/eng/#main\_public05.htm">http://www.cmchk.org.hk/cmp/eng/#main\_public05.htm</a>), the medical certificates should include the full name and the HKID number of the patient as well as the name and registration number of the attending practitioner. Thus, when you submit a medical certificate issued by a registered Chinese medicine practitioner, please ensure that your HKID number is printed on the certificate.

Applications for absence from examinations will be reviewed by the College's Board of Examiners. The decision by the Board of Examiners is final and the application results will be announced in the Learner Portal upon the release of assessment results (i.e. on 15 February 2024). Students will also receive a written notification of their application results individually.

For approved applications, students will be notified of the make-up examination arrangements and required to attend the make-up examination accordingly. A tentative schedule of the make-up examinations is attached in **Appendix IV(A)**.

Students whose applications are not accepted by the Board of Examiners will receive a fail grade for the course.

Please note that students will only be permitted to take the make-up examination of the same course ONCE during the registration of their respective programmes. No further arrangements would be made for students who are absent from the approved make-up examinations of the same course. They will receive a fail grade for the course concerned and be required to repeat the failed course as appropriate in the next available semester.

#### Notes:

- Make-up examinations may be arranged on weekdays and weekends, during morning to evening time
  periods. Please be reminded that it is students' responsibility to check their timetables, and promptly
  notify the College Office of any discrepancies. If students are not able to access the make-up examination
  timetable in the Learner Portal or do not receive any notification nearer the time, please reach out to the
  College Office.
